



Course Details





The 2017/18 cohort is currently in progress and due to finish in July 2018. We will be advertising for the next cohort in July 2018.



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

Biomedical Research Centre at Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust and King's College London

The National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) Biomedical Research Centre at Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust is run in partnership with King's College London.

As one of the first five biomedical research centres in England we were funded by the NIHR to help establish the UK's translational biomedical research infrastructure. In April 2012, as recognition for our outstanding contribution to healthcare research, we were awarded a further five years funding due to the significant progress made in translational research and innovation.

Our NIHR Biomedical Research Centre runs research method courses to help healthcare professionals design and conduct high quality research studies.

The courses cover:-

- 1. Quantitative research methods
- 2. Qualitative research methods
- 3. General issues in conducting research
- 4. Finding evidence sessions

These sessions run in spring and autumn each year. The courses are free and only eligible for healthcare professionals employed by the following organisations:-
